La vie de Boheme ART QUILTS:

Favorite heavy bodied, fluid/ink acrylic colors

Golden acrylic glazing medium Satin

1- 8.5" x 11" Plexiglas sheet (acrylic sheet)

1/2 yd. Muslin or Kona cotton

Misc. papers to paint and dye 15-20 pieces (up to 12"x18") – heavy drawing paper, watercolor, copy paper, ledger, sheet music, newsprint, paper bags, envelopes, maps, craft, graph and found papers.

1 yd. Heat-n-bond Lite

Inkjet photos

Collage ephemera/paper scraps-various colors & textures

15- 2-ply white paper towels (Kirkland from Costco, these are for painting)

2" flat brush (hardware store brushes work great)

Plastic paint scrapper

2- 1" foam brushes

2 water containers

1 hard rubber brayer

1 soft rubber brayer

Black chisel tip sharpie

A few favorite doodling tools-prismacolor pencils, gel pens/ markers

Scissors

Painting smock

Parchment paper

Optional:

Black & white photocopies of images/writing/journal pages/line art - sharp contrast images work best.

Sewing machine/thread –if you'd like to do stitching I would suggest to bring your own. If not, you can also glue/fuse collages.

Favorite unmounted stamps, stencils, printing tools

Adjective bank/theme brainstorm a list of words, quotes, phrases

GRAFFITI BAUBLES: Journal/Necklace

20-30 painted papers from previous workshop and (up to 12"x18") – heavy drawing paper, watercolor, copy paper, ledger, sheet music, newsprint, paper bags, envelopes, maps, craft, graph and found papers)

Black & white photocopies of images/writing/ journal pages/line art

Collage ephemera/paper scraps in various colors & textures

5 – sheets of freezer paper

2" flat brush (hardware store brushes work great)

2- 1" foam brushes

Awl

2 binder clips

paper/bookbinding needle

metal ruler

waxed linen

water containers

Golden soft gel gloss (16oz.)

Scissors

Black chisel tip sharpie

Painting smock

20 - 24 gauge metal wire/craft wire

various beads and baubles (look for costume jewelry at the thrift store to take apart)

jewelry needle nose pliers

jewelry round nose pliers

jewelry wire cutters

Optional supplies:

sewing machine – if you would like to create a journal embellished with stitching, this is required. You also have the option to glue/fuse/tape/hand sew if you don't bring a sewing machine

Doodling tools-prismacolor pencils, gel pens, glitter/paint markers

Favorite unmounted stamps, stencils, printing tools
