

# Student Tool List – Found Objects

This class will explore a more formal approach to working with “found objects” than you often see. We will use a plethora of techniques to help you find and develop your artistic voice. In addition to those special treasures that you want to learn how to set, imprint, rivet or otherwise make into jewelry pieces, I would like for you to bring the following:

## Basic Hand Tools

- Pliers – Round Nose and Flat Nose
- Flush Cutters
- 6” – 8” Flat and Half-Round Files
- Needle File Set
- Rawhide Mallet
- Bench pin and Anvil
- Sawframe and Blades
- Sandpaper
- Bezel Pusher
- Burnisher
- Ring Clamp
- Metal Shears – I really like the Lindstrom shears (Rio # 111-289 for \$28.00)
- Riveting Hammer (if you have one)

## Materials and Supplies

- Notebook and Pen
- Your “found objects” – You need to bring the ones you want to work with and at least 12 items to trade/share. You know how intriguing someone else’s treasures are... this is your opportunity to share yours and trade for some new ones!
- Solder – Hard, Medium and Easy wire solder
- Stabrite Solder / Sta Clean Flux (Rio #503-031 for \$12.50)

## Wire and Sheet Metal

Please bring a variety of sheet metal and wire that you enjoy working with. This class will focus on you finding your artistic voice with your materials.

## Materials for Purchase in Class

- Rivets (or rivet wire)
- Solder
- Sawblades
- Assorted Red Brass, Copper and Silver wire and sheet
