Tools you normally use in throwing. This should include:

- cut-off wire
- needle tool
- fettling knife
- wooden potter's knife
- a rib or two
- trimming tools (+ bring an extra one to alter during class)
- sponge
- chamois
- towel
- water bucket

And -- anything else you are used to using when throwing or handbuilding, along with a selection of brushes for applying slips and glazes, and a pair of scissors.

Optional, but highly recommended: an Exacto knife and a Surform Shaver (a grater-like wood-working tool that's great with clay). Bring a selection of texturing tools/objects -your choice, but something unique to you would be wonderful. I'll bring a boxful of tools and texture items that everyone can try.

NOTE: The ceramics studio at Idyllwild has a number of these tools on hand.
