Tool & Supply List

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Basic Tools:

Jeweler's Saw frame & Blades

Jeweler's Pliers

Wire Cutters

Files (6" of 8" Mill Bastard) & jeweler's files

Forging Hammer (ball peen is fine)

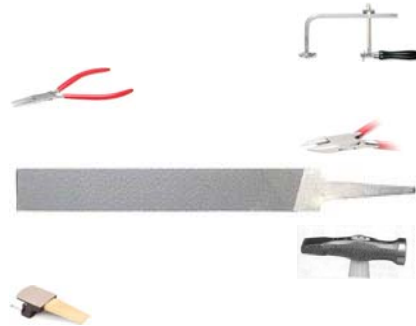
Bench Pin

Soldering Pick

Wet-or-Dry sandpaper (One sheet each #220, #320, #400)

Hand Drill or Flex shaft.

Reading glasses or Opti-Visor



Materials:

20 & 18 Gauge Copper and Sterling Sheet (2"x6" of each)

20 & 18 Gauge Copper and Sterling Wire (6' of each)

8 & 6 Gauge silver (1' of each)

Silver Solder (medium & hard)

20 Tie Tack Pin backs and clutches

The pin back should be the type used with silver solder and with small heads.

Chose whichever tie tack clutch you wish.

(We will be making enough pins for each student to trade with all of the other students in the class and the instructor.)

I will bring thick walled sterling silver tubing, stainless steel wire and appropriate drill bits for students to buy and use.
