This class is about you learning to solder well and to be comfortable with the process. You are encouraged to bring items you have struggled with or that you would like to be able to solder. In addition, I would like for you to bring the following items:

Basic Hand Tools

- Pliers – Round Nose and Flat Nose
- Flush Cutters
- 6” – 8” Flat and Half-Round Files
- Needle File Set
- Rawhide Mallet
- Bench pin and Anvil
- Sawframe and Blades
- Sandpaper
- Bezel Pusher
- Burnisher
- Ring Clamp

Materials and Supplies

- Notebook and Pen
- 3 small containers for solder Pallions – (each should be different to minimize confusion)
- Stone(s) to bezel set
- Solder – Hard, Medium and Easy wire solder
- Stabrite Solder / Sta Clean Flux (Rio #503-031 for \$12.50)
- Whiteout (from an office supply)

Wire and Sheet Metal

- 18 or 20ga Red Brass sheet – 6”x 12”
- Silver Square Wire – 16ga and 14ga – approx. 2”each
- Silver Round Wire – 18ga, 16ga, and 14ga – or other sizes you have
- Silver, Copper or Red Brass you are interested in working with

Materials for Purchase in Class

- 26ga fine silver bezel wire
- Stones
- Solder
- Sawblades
- Assorted Red Brass, Copper and Silver
