## 2018 Idyllwild Arts Summer Program

The Idyllwild Arts Summer Program offers workshops in **ceramics, painting, photography, creative writing, filmmaking, dance, theatre, music, and more**. Workshops are offered during July and August and run from one to four weeks long. We are located between Palm Springs and Riverside in the beautiful San Jacinto Mountains of Southern California.

The Native American Youth Scholarship is designed for students ages 9 – 18, with current tribal affiliation and financial need. The expenses covered include tuition, lab fee, dorm housing, and all meals in the campus dining hall. Students are responsible for their transportation to and from Idyllwild. We ask that all students participate financially by paying the \$50 Application Fee. Note: If you need assistance with the Application Fee or Transportation expenses, please contact the Summer Program Registrar.

Students should apply as soon as possible to ensure that there is space in the workshops they select. If you would like assistance with the online application form or have questions, the Summer Program Registrar will be happy to assist you.
