Materials to Bring:

- Sawframe
- Sawblades 3/0
- Lubricant for sawblades
- Bench Pin
- Files
- Needle Files
- Assorted Sandpaper (wet/dry)
- Ring Clamp (wood preferred)
- Pliers (Round/Flat/etc.)
- Wire cutters
- Scribe
- 6" ruler
- Tweezers
- Magnifying glasses (if needed)
- ½ flat ½ round needle nose pliers if they can be found
- Chasing hammer
- Planishing hammer and/or watchmakers hammer
- Double ended pin vise for cutting tubing
- Your favorite assorted drill, burrs, and abrasive wheels for flex shaft use
- Fine tipped dividers
- Soldering picks and tweezers
- Fine and ultra fine tipped sharpie
- Mechanical pencil and eraser as well as your favorite drafting and design tools and supplies
- Bring any projects and/or designs you are working on that you will want to make findings for as well as any stones or beads that you might want to embellish your findings with as well as bezel wire or crowns needed for the stones.

Optional:

- Task light for your bench
- Flex Shaft, Stand and flex shaft tools
- Bench Pin with "C" Clamp

Your lab fee covers:

- Kit of sterling silver sheet
- Wire and tubing as required for specialized projects

- The use of all tools, equipment, and consumables such as solder and compounds
