

Hot Clay: The Poetics of Glaze Chemistry

Materials to Bring:

- 50-100 bisqued test tiles made from a cone 6 clay body, 2" or less in any direction
- 6 slabs or thrown plate forms to serve as catch basins under tiles in the kiln (each one can hold 4-6 tiles)
- brushes
- black underglaze pencil
- one package of 16-ounce plastic cups
- quart containers with lids
- respirator or N-95 dust mask
- 10 ml syringe with slip tip
- basic clay tools for making test tiles (pin tool, stiff rib for compressing, sponge, texture tools, etc.)
- digital scale with accuracy to .1 g and capacity from 1000 to 5000 g

Optional:

- 80 mesh test sieve
- Immersion blender
