

iPhoneography: It's Not Just Luck
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Materials to Bring:

- iPhones/iPads, stylus, and flash drives if you use them for extra storage
- Charging cables and plugs that fit your devices
- External batteries, if you have them.
- A notebook and pens to take written notes
- Apps for your devices - to be downloaded BEFORE arrival onto both devices (when possible)
 - iColorama S (for iPhone) and iColorama (for iPad)
 - Snapseed
 - Stackables
 - LightBrush
 - Exif Wizard Pro
 - SuperimposeX
 - Handy Photo
 - Touch Retouch
 - Procreate (for iPad)
 - Cameras: Blackie, Camera+, ProCamera with HDR and Low light extensions
- If you have an Apple Pencil, by all means, bring it.

Your lab fee covers:

- 5-7 sheets Epson printing paper
- Printer inks

Note: This class will be taught on iOS devices and presumes you have one or more late model iPhones or iPads. (iPhone 6 minimum on iOS 10; iPad Pro minimum iOS 10. It is not necessary to have both an iPhone and an iPad, but I presume all participants will have an iPhone with at least 64GB storage. More is always better so you may want to get a USB wireless backup drive.)
